Beginner Spanish 3 and Intermediate Spanish 1

Students in this class are expected to have some familiarity with the language and at least 1.5-2 years of intensive formal Spanish instruction, as this session will build on Spanish I.and 2. Using ChiCeLaCu's online materials, the focus will be on building vocabulary and developing reading and writing skills. The first part of the course will focus on verb conjugation. Students will begin forming basic sentences on various topics ranging from the human body, emotions, the home, family, community, etc. Students will learn while enjoying many fun and interactive activities. The second part of the course will focus on pronouns, prepositions, and possessives. Students will be introduced to AR, ER, and IR (irregular) verbs through various activities and practice conjugation in the first person, using storytelling, videos, music, songs, and plenty of games.

Advanced students will learn and apply irregular verbs (to be, to like, to have, to go). To make this a more dynamic and interesting experience, cultural aspects from various countries as well as drawing, music, theater, arts and crafts elements will be integrated into the course.
